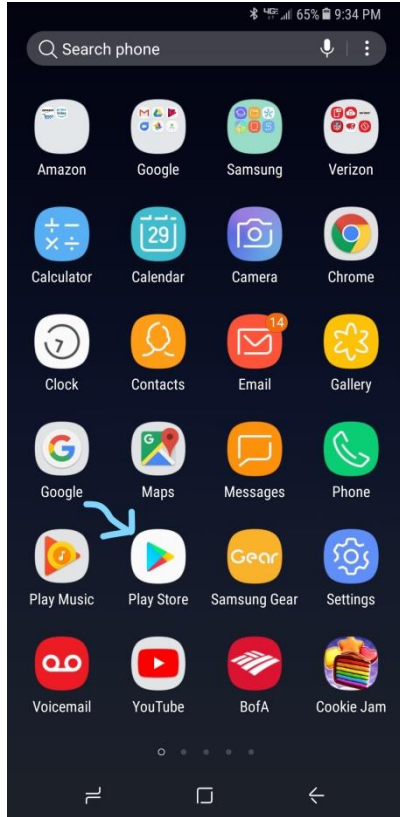


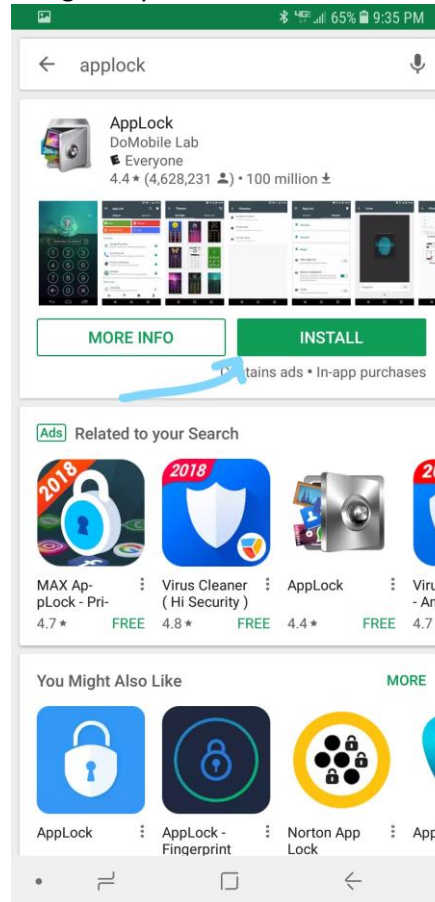
Guide to setup Applock for any android smartphone or tablet:

1. The phone will ask you to sign in for a google account, you can use the child's gmail login for their google account. (if you sign in with your own account it may allow them access to your email). If they don't have an account you can set one up for them from the google site.

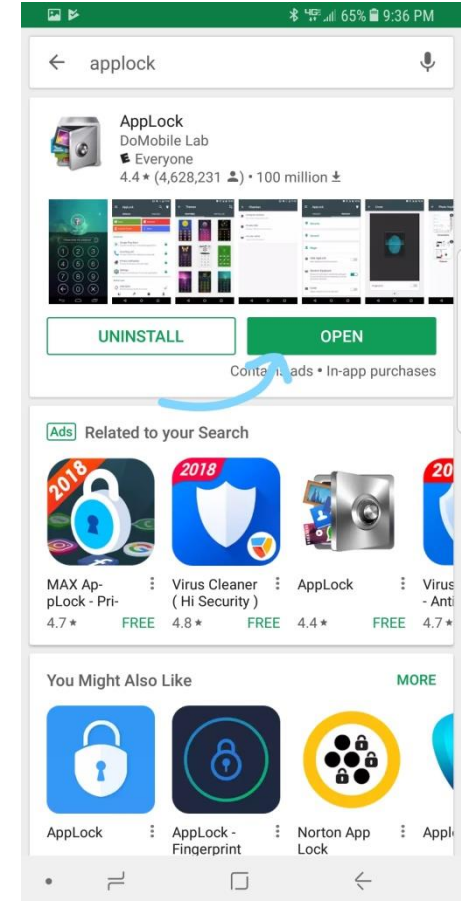
2. Go to Google Play app on the phone



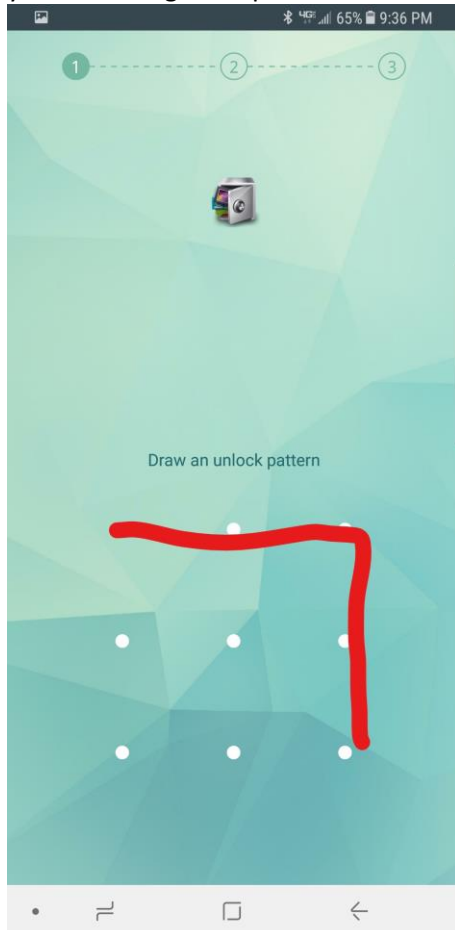
3. Search for AppLock (by DoMobile Lab) in the Google Play Store and click on install



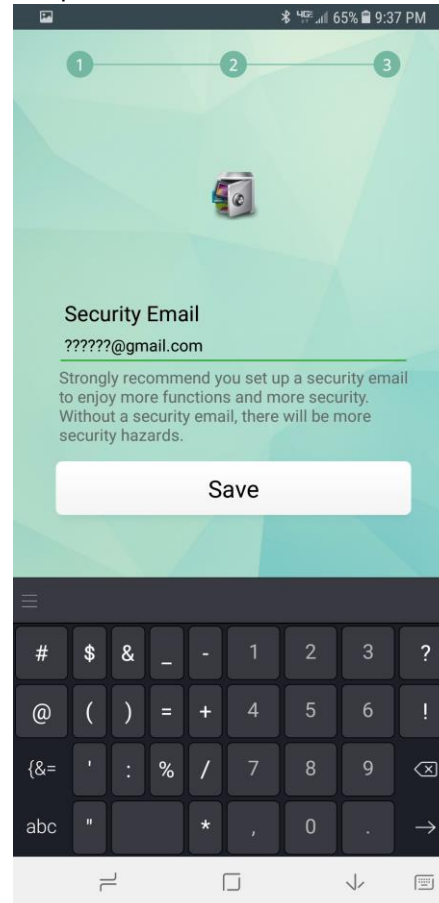
4. Click on open to open app



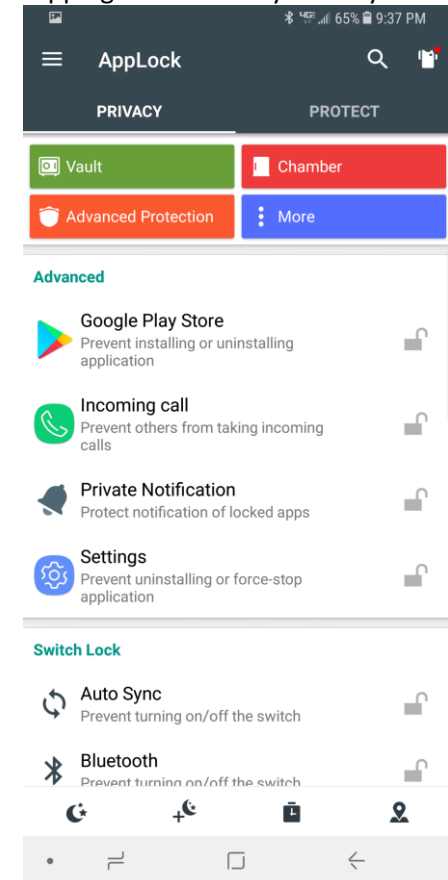
5. It will ask for a pattern lock, you will need to temporarily set this to a pattern, later you can change to a password



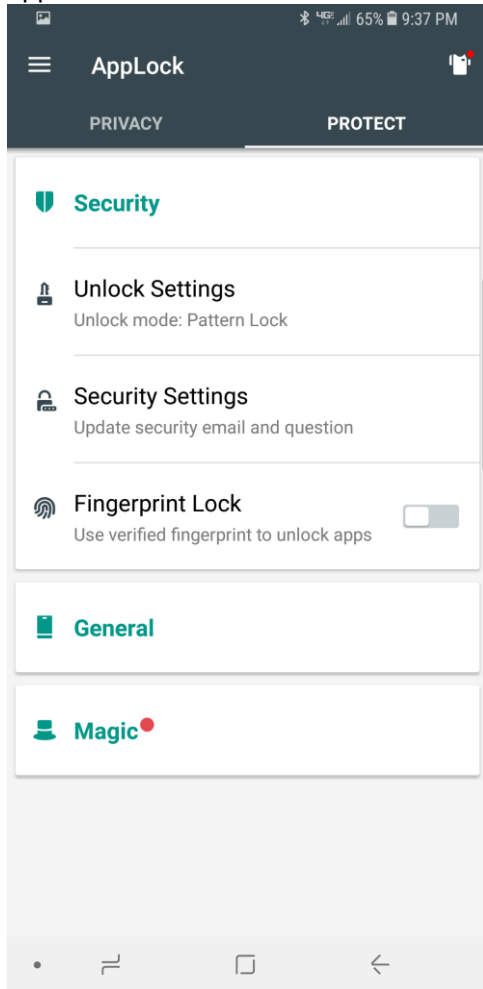
6. It will next ask for a security email, this will allow you to be notified and be able to reset the password.



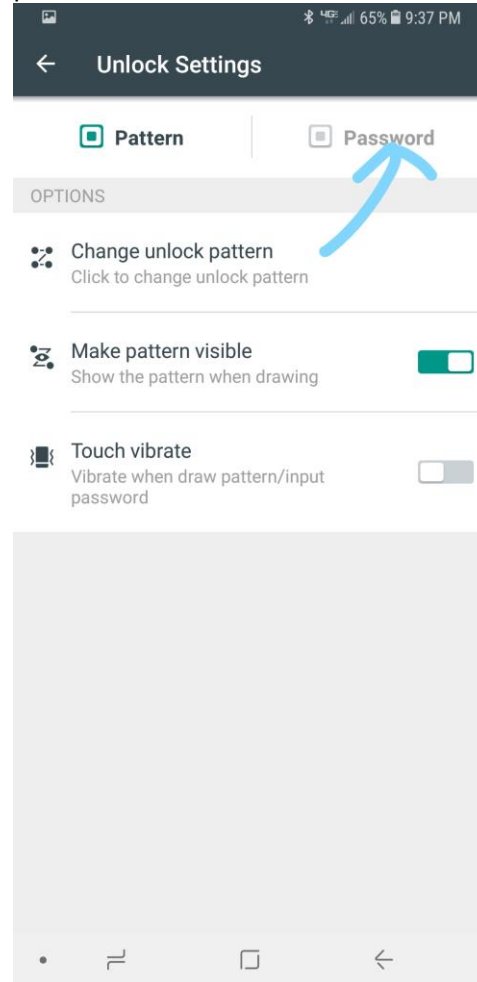
7. This is the main screen of the app, you will see "Privacy" tab and "Protect" tab. The privacy tab allows you to lock apps by tapping on the lock symbol by each one



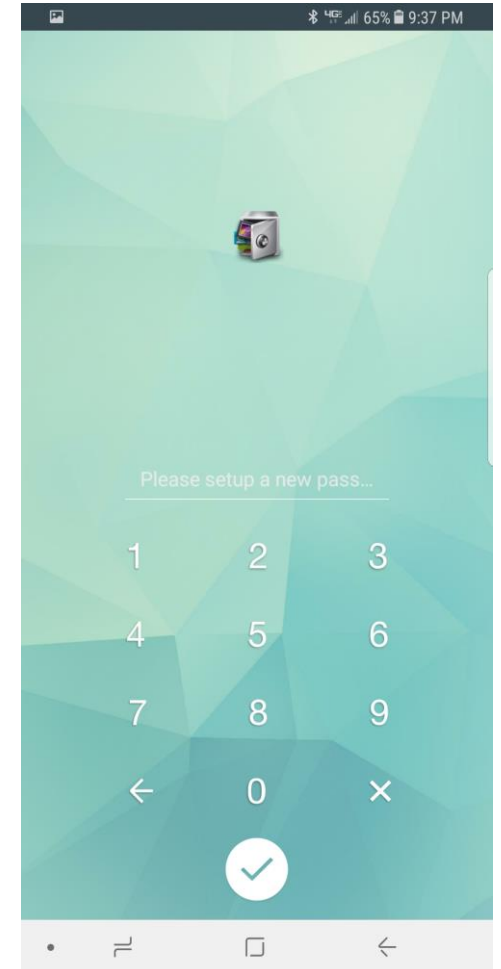
8. The Protect tab is where you set the password or pattern lock that allows access to Applock app and other locked apps



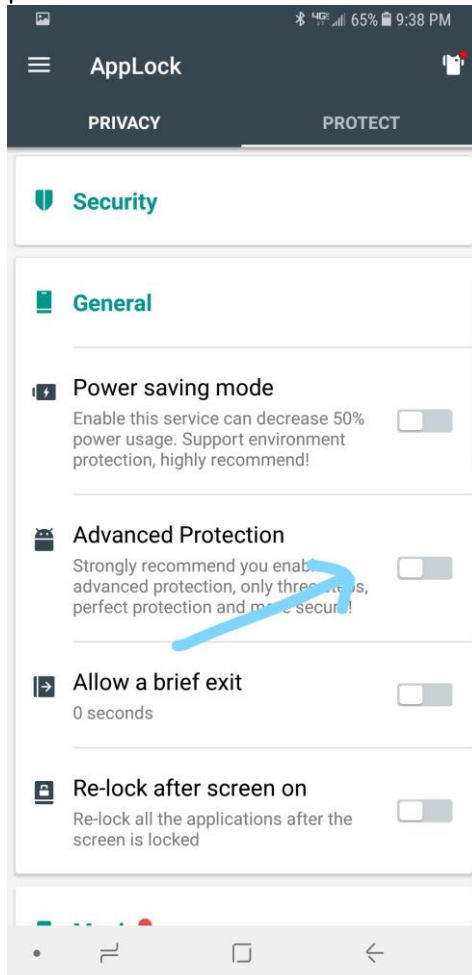
9. Tap on Unlock settings to change from "pattern lock" to "password" Tap on password



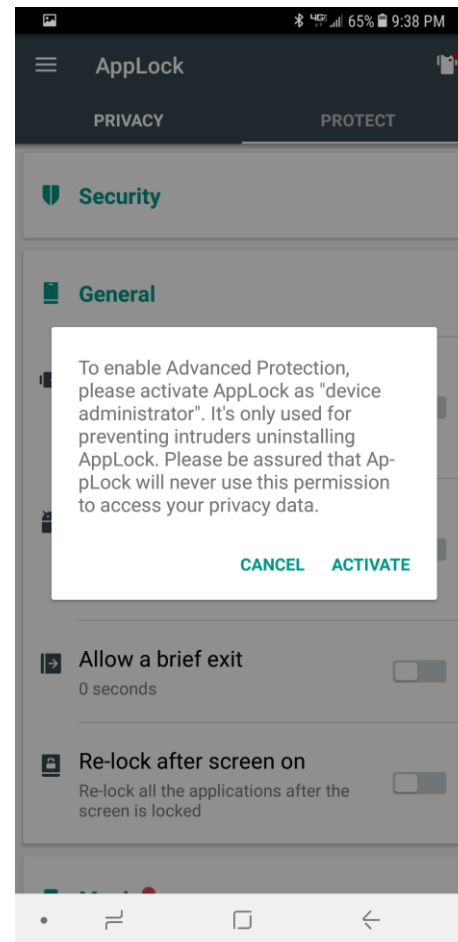
10. Enter a password that you can remember but won't be easy to guess. You will need to enter it twice.



11. Enable advanced protection: this makes sure the app cannot be uninstalled. Go to General and click on advanced protection.



12. Follow the prompts to activate device administrator.



13. Back in the privacy tab click on the lock symbols to lock apps. See list of apps recommendations. You can also save a lock "profile" by tapping on add profile
